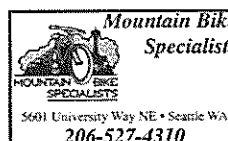

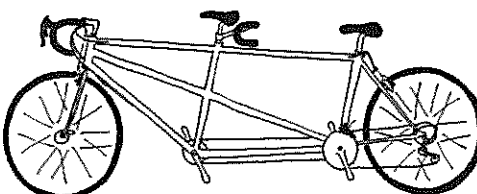

Wait until you see what we have! Never been seen anywhere on this planet before! Mark your calendar for Sept 19 - Admission is free! Do you or anyone you know ever get confused about how to switch which derailleur, which way, when? Fret no more. The mystery is solved. "Speed Control" to the rescue. This local company has devised a simple derailleur-less system that makes it easy to change gears.

Presently, when you shift, it clicks and you might not have to reach all the way down to get to your levers. But you still have 2 or 4 levers or buttons, it takes two hands, and there is no obvious logic to the system.

With Speed Control you have only one shifter, which is a rotating grip. All you do is turn it towards you to go faster and away from you to pedal easier. The gear changing is all done internally inside the rear hub. The gears are as wide spread as a standard triple crankset and 8 speed cassette would give you. As you move the lever it gets harder or easier to pedal, as if magically. The transitions are smooth and gentle. If you only turn the lever a little bit, the change will be small. If you turn it quite a bit, the gearing will change quite a bit.

We are excited to be working with the folks at Speed Control. They have been fine tuning this innovative idea for 5 years and it is finally ready for the public. We think they have a great product and we want our customers to be the first in the world to try this amazing shifting system. We think it is the system of the future! We want you to experience it, and their engineers want your feedback.

We have 10 bikes equipped with "Speed Control", waiting for you to try. They'll be here and available for a free test ride from Wed. Sept 16 through Sat. Sept 27. About a year ago, Estelle Gray invited me and my wife (Kat) to a tandem class. Neither Kat and I had ridden a tandem before and we were intrigued. After some instruction and a couple of spins with Estelle, we were off pedaling a Rodriguez "Toucan". Not more than ten minutes into our ride, we were thinking about the possibilities of a tandem for our next adventure.

There was a problem though. Our schedules don't always mesh and it looked like I would be leaving for Cuba 2 to 3 weeks before Kat did. It looked like a tandem was out of the question.

But thanks to the imagination and innovation of the folks at R + E (Matt & John), we will be able to ride a tandem after all...an "Eight-Ball."



The Rodriguez "Eight-Ball" is a tandem built with S & S couplings, which allows the frame to come apart for easy packing and traveling. This is not unique. Most custom bikes have an "S & S" option. What makes the "Eight-Ball" unique, is that it uses a couple more couplings (seven total on our tandem) and is designed so that the middle comes out and the front and back of the bike screw together and "presto chango" you have a single bike.

You have to see it to believe it! It is so well designed that the first time I tried, I was able to convert it from a single bike to a tandem in less than twenty minutes!

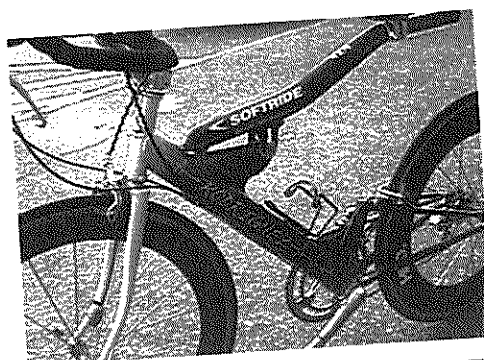
World Class Triathlete Sally Edwards

TO V-BRAKE or NOT TO V-BRAKE

Hmmm.....



V-Brakes on tandems?



In the last few years, mountain bikes have been coming with V-Brakes (or linear cantilevers) as standard equipment. The brake arm, or 'lever' of a linear cantilever is longer, giving the rider a bit of a mechanical advantage. Another difference is the brake pad, it is much longer so it gives more pad contact on the rim. Some of the more expensive V-Brakes use a parallelogram design for the pad. This parallelogram gives the pad a smooth inward travel as opposed to a curved path of travel.

For mountain biking these brakes improved stopping so well, that some people thought, including me, that they would be a natural step into the tandem world. An obstacle stood in place though. Because of the longer lever, V-Brakes required a brake lever that would pull more cable, and these longer pull levers are only available in mountain bike style levers. Most of our tandem customers prefer drop, or road style bars. Well, it wasn't long before someone came out with an adapter that would increase the pull through a road bike lever. The first one available was the Com-Tech device made by a company in Montana. The first shop in the country to buy them was R+E Cycles. I ordered them before they were being produced, and the salesman left me a prototype to install for demos.

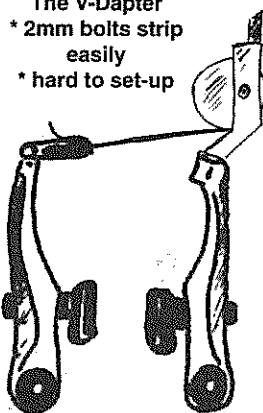
When the first production pair of Com-Tech devices arrived, I fitted up a new Rodriguez tandem for use with a set of the Shimano Deore XT V-Brakes (the kind with the parallelogram pad travel) for Estelle and I to ride in the tandem rally. The setup seemed simple at first, but then the fine tuning was more involved. It was very difficult to adjust the pads so that the brakes didn't squeak when applied. It seemed that when they didn't squeak, they didn't brake very well. I finally settled on a happy medium, and we were off to the rally.

After unloading the bike from the car, and reinstalling the front wheel, I noticed that the front brake was no longer centered. I would discover that I would have to center these brakes a number of times over the week-end, or they would rub. After about 50 miles, the squeak returned and never went away. The brakes really didn't seem to perform as well as my standard recommendation (good quality cantilevers with Mathausen big block pads). The XT brake pads seemed softer than any compound that I usually recommend, and didn't perform well on long, steep descents. In fact, I had my levers buried at one point, and still couldn't slow the bike enough to hold the line around a blind curve. After 200 miles, I noticed that the pads were almost worn through! If you ride with wide tires, there is still one more problem with V-brakes that you should know about. Because of the longer brake shoe, the V-brakes won't open enough to allow easy removal of your wheel, so you'll have to deflate the tire. One weekend of squeaking, adjusting, and poor performance convinced me that V-brakes were not the answer for me.

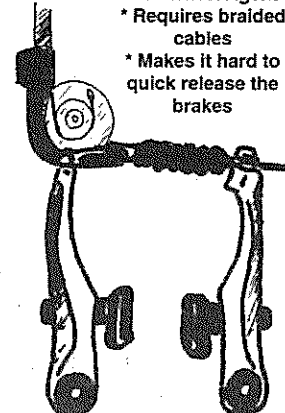
In the meantime, a few more cable pull enhancing devices have come out, including the V-dapter, and the Travel Agent adapter. I have tried V-brakes with these products also. Amazingly enough, the first invention from Com-Tech (the patent has since been sold to Sidetrack) works the best. With the V-dapter, the brakes were even harder to adjust. The

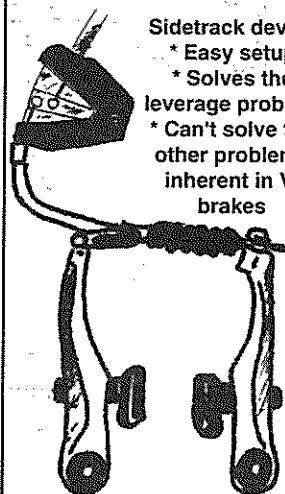

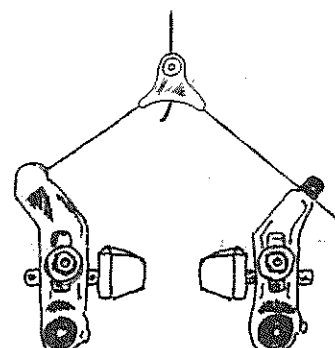

Travel Agent seems to be a good design, but eliminates the ability to easily quick release the brakes when you want to remove your tire.

Final thoughts on V-brakes on tandems:

If you are using mountain bike style handlebars, you can use the appropriate style levers to make the V-brakes work properly, and they stop the bike well, but still have the centering problems, the rapid pad wear, and wide tire removal clearance problems.

If you are using drop style handlebars, you need to use some type of device to increase your cable pull. Brake centering problems, difficulty of set-up, fast brake pad wear, squeaking, and poor performance after heating up are all problems that seem to be consistent with V-brakes on drop bar tandems. (I can't set up a pair of traditional cantilevers to work much better than any type of V-brake, and you'll have none of these problems)

None the less, V-brakes do look cool, and they are the newest thing out, and the magazines all seem to like them, so we do still sell a lot of them.

At Rodriguez, we like to ride products, and like them before we recommend them. But when we sell a tandem, the customer can choose V-Brakes, or cantilever brakes. There is no extra charge for either, and we keep both in stock.
